## I – ANNOUNCEMENT



### LAKES TROPHY

The ice skating club of Meudon is pleased to announce the « Lakes Trophy », an interclub competition for the categories Chicks, Cubs, Debs, Novices and Juniors with free program only.

This competition will take place on the [ice rink of UCPA Sport Station Meudon](#) [April 4, 5 & 6 2026](#).

#### I.1 GENERAL REGULATIONS

The « Lakes Trophy 2026 » will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications, or any updates published by the date of the commencement of the event.

Participation in Lakes Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to the ISU Rules in effect. All participants' ages must fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rules and they must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in the ISU Rules & Communications in effect or any updates published at the time of the commencement of the competition.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

#### I.2 SPORTITY APP

The Sportity-app can be downloaded via Google Playstore or Apple app store. All relevant competition information will be published on the App (incl. Entries & Results).

### III.1 ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS

The « Lakes Trophy » Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation with a maximum of four (5) skaters per category. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of entries per club or / and enter more than four skaters. Entries of skaters may be made only by the club concerned on the designated official forms.

Please note that the ISU-competition « Rooster Cup », will take place at the same time. Details are stated in a separate announcement.

#### III.2.1 ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Members may nominate one international / National (1) judge and one substitute Judge.

The Entries of Judges must be done no later than **March 6th 2026**.



OC will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all nominated judges from ISU Members, except travel costs who will be covered by ISU Member.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 5 Judges.

### III.2.2 ENTRIES FEES

- Lakes Trophy categories: 60€

—> Entry Fees should be paid not later than **Monday, March 6 , 2026** by bank transfer to the following account (Entries are only accepted, once the Entry Fees have reached the Organizers account.) The entry fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawals.

- Entry fee will be refunded if the skater is not accepted (if there will be a limitation of the numbers of entries).

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the “UCPA Sport Station Ice Rink” upon arrival.

## **VIII - RESULTS, DRAW AND FREE SKATING STARTING ORDER**

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating, Rules 352 and 353.

Interclub victory ceremonies will be held off ice as soon as possible after the free programs of each category ends for all participants.  
A schedule will be provided.

Each Skater will receive a medal in the kiss and cry after her/his performance.

## **IX - INITIAL JUDGES MEETING / ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION**

The initial Judges meeting and the Technical panel meeting will be held at the ice rink Friday evening, April 3rd 2026. The exact times will be announced by the referee and Technical specialist. Round Table Discussions will be held Sunday and Monday.

## **X - INSURANCE / LIABILITY**

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member’s team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.
